3. Identity Card.

Identity Card will be issued to students and they should take signature of Principal within 15 days from the date of admission. It is mandatory on the part of the students to carry their identity card. If in case the I card is found missing, the student will not be allowed to enter the college premises. If the I card is lost a duplicate I card will be issued on a payment of Rs. 50/- Students should bring their Identify Cards daily.

4. Common Fine

Common fine will be imposed on the class if the class furniture and college property is found damaged.

5. Cycle Stand & Security Services :

At the time of admission, students will have to pay 150/- as cycle stand & security fee.

College will not be responsible if the vehicles are not properly locked.

- The fee structure mentioned in the prospectus should be strictly followed. All college fees should be paid before submitting the university examination form.
- Smoking, Gutka chewing and ragging are strictly prohibited in the campus. Offenders shall be liable to face legal action.
- Students should keep campus clean and maintain discipline in the campus.
- Students should bring their identity cards daily.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Library

The college library is well equipped with text books reference books and Encyclopedias. It is expected of the students that they take proper care of the books and furniture. All the rules and regulations concerning the library will be displayed on the notice board.

Students will be fined if the books are not returned on time or if the books are tampered Books will be issued only to those students who produce their indentify card. If books are not returned within 15 days students will be fined 50 paisa per day.

2. Games and Sports

The college encourages the students to participate in various games. The college has facilities for games like Volley Ball, Basket Ball, Badminton, Cricket, Kho-kho, Kabaddi etc. Special awards are given to students who excel in sports.

It is obligatory for the students to take part in NCC, NSS or Sports.

3. Cultural Activities

Conventional type of social gathering shall not be held according to University rules. Instead, college will hold cultural programmes so as to provide a platform to explore the hidden talent of the students. College encourages and provide opportunities to participate in Youth Festival and various other cultural activities throughout the session. The college has produced colour holders in Youth Festival events.

4. College Magazine and Wall Magazine

College Magazine and Wall magazines are published by editorial board consisting of faculty and students who have a flair for writing.

5. Incentive Marks:

Amravati University provides incentive marks to students opting for N.C.C, N. S. S., Extra Curricular and Co-Curricular activities. More information regarding incentive marks is available with the concerned officer in charge.

6. UGC Sponsored Remedial Coaching for Backward and Minority Students:

The college runs a scheme for academically weak students those of Backward and minority classes for improving their academic performance. **Co-ordinator :- Prof. Vijay Bhangre**

7. College Societies/Associations:

Subject wise college societies/associations are formed to promote co-curricular activities and competencies. For overall development it is compulsory for each student to be an active member of at least one society or association. For details contact faculty in-charge or concern head of the department.





8. Botanical Garden :

College has a beautiful Botanical Garden with many rare medicinal and other useful plants.

9. Guardian Teacher Scheme :

Each student admitted in the college is placed under the personal supervision and guidance of a teacher who act as a friend and philosopher and keeps a record of student's progress. Each student should contact his/her guardian teacher regularly. For getting scholarship, freeship, admission card, etc. it is necessary to obtain clearance from the Guardian teacher.

10. Research facilities :

The college has university recognized research laboratories in Botany and Geography.

11. Student Grievances/ Redressal Cell :

This cell takes care of general grievances of students.

12. Prevention of Sexual Harassment Cell :

This cell is constituted to develop a conducive atmosphere in the campus, where the status of women is respected and they are treated with equality.

13. Suggestion Box :

A suggestion box is kept in college. The students should use this for giving positive suggestions and avoid personalized comments.

14. Career and Counseling Cell:

The college runs a career and counseling cell for guiding the students to choose for higher studies, skill and job oriented courses. **Co-ordinator - Prof.Nitin Tatte**

15. U.G.C. Sponsered coaching for entry in services :

College runs coaching classes for entry in services for SC/ ST/ OBC & minority students admitted in the college . For details contact - **Prof. Pandit Kale**

16. Awards

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Rules & Regulation :

1. It shall be the duty of every student to abide by the rules and regulations of the college, and to conduct himself with discipline and decorum in all places and under all circumstances.
2. Every student shall attend classes regularly and punctually and shall refrain from any action that may disturb the smooth working of the college.
3. When classes are in session, students shall not enter or leave the class rooms without the permission of the teachers concerned.
4. Students who may be free during class-time shall not loiter on the Verandah or on the premises of the college. During such time they are to be in the Library/Reading room.
5. Every student shall handle college property with care and shall do everything in his/her power to preserve cleanliness and tidiness of the furniture, building and the premises. Students shall not disfigure the walls, doors, windows, furniture etc. with bills, engraving etc.
6. The loss or damage or disfigurement caused to the college articles will be made good by realizing double the loss or damages so incurred from the concerned students or through a collective fine covering all the students.
7. Megaphones, loudspeakers, mobile phones etc should not be used in the campus without the permission of the Principal. Posters, flags, memorial tombs, floral arches, festoons etc. should not be displayed in the campus.
8. Students shall not invite or encourage outsiders to enter the campus.
9. Ragging/teasing/intimidating/harassing/using words of abuse etc. on junior students'especially female students with in the campus or outside are punishable/crime under Police Act and such matters will be immediately reported to the police. Students involved in such acts will be adequately punished which amount to
 - i. Imprisonment upto 2 years and
 - ii. A fine upto Rs. 10,000/- and
 - iii. Dismissal from the College
10. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each period. Late comers shall enter class-rooms only with the permission of the teacher.
11. Application for leave of absence for more than 4 days due to illness should be supported by medical certificates.
12. The responsibility of making sure that a student has earned the required minimum percentage of attendance (75% for the year) rests entirely upon the student. **The University insists on a minimum of 75% attendance during the course of instruction for permitting students to take the examination.** The College expects a much higher percentage of attendance than the minimum 75% required by the University. It is the responsibility of parents and guardians to find out from the Department concerned the attendance score of their wards from time to time.
13. Any further rules and regulations framed by the Management and the Principal from time to time shall also be binding to all.

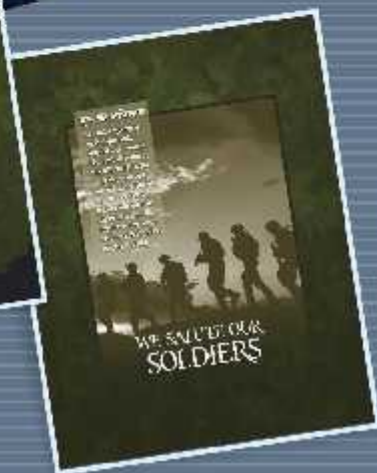
